### Timely Filing a Notice of Loss

The CCC-576, Notice of Loss, is used to report failed acreage and prevented planting and may be completed by any producer with an interest in the crop. Timely filing a Notice of Loss is required for all crops including grasses. For losses on crops covered by the Non-Insured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP), **you must file a CCC-576, Notice of Loss, in the FSA County Office within 15 days of the occurrence of the disaster or when losses become apparent or 15 calendar days after the normal harvest date.**

Notification can be provided by filing a CCC-576, by email, fax or phone. Producers who notify the County Office by any method other than by filing the CCC-576 are still required to file a CCC-576, Notice of Loss, within the required 15 calendar days.

Please make sure we have copies of your current leases. These are required to receive NAP benefits.

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## Importance of Current Leases

To receive benefits for many of the disaster programs, you are required to have, on-file, a **current** copy of all leases in the Campbell County Office. Please bring in any leases that have been updated since the 2012 /2013 disaster program benefits were paid.

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## Important Deadline Reminders:

### 2016 ARC/PLC Contracts

Please contact the county FSA Office to get an appointment to complete your 2016 ARC/PLC contracts. The signup began Dec. 7,

2015 and will end **August 1, 2016**. Producers are urged to call for appointments so that we can have your paperwork ready for you.

### **FSA County Committee Nomination Period in Campbell County Ends August 1**

Nomination forms must be postmarked or received in the Campbell County FSA Office by close of business on Aug. 1, 2016. Producers may nominate themselves or others as candidates. Organizations representing minority and women farmers and ranchers may also nominate candidates. To become a nominee, eligible individuals must sign form FSA-669A. Elected county committee members serve a three-year term and are responsible for making decisions on FSA disaster, conservation, commodity and price support programs, as well as other important federal farm program issues. The Campbell County committee consist of three members.
